Dear Mr Suzic,

Further to Paul Keene's e-mail to you of 24th August, I am writing as the co-owner of 24 Myddleton Square to endorse his views and to confirm that as a resident of Myddelton Square for nearly 20 years I am absolutely opposed to any suggestion that there should be any charge for the use of the square gardens. I believe that (as is currently the case), the gardens should be used by all residents and individuals living in the neighbourhood as a local amenity. This has been the case since the gardens were created and should continue to be the case. It has been acknowledged that that it was an oversight that the freehold of the square was not purchased by the Council and it is my view that the compulsory purchase should proceed as soon as possible to ensure the continued public access to the gardens.
